



# WHAT IS THE GORÉE PROJECT?

A first-of-its-kind experience, following the journey of two African-Americans to Senegal, West Africa to swim in the Gorée Festival where they will serve as African-American cultural-leadership ambassadors via proficiency in sport.

Our swimmers will retrace the path of enslaved Africans while swimming alongside their Senegalese cousins from the shore of Dakar to the Island of Gorée. Black Kids Swim (BKS) will follow their preparation in the midst of a COVID-19 pandemic and global civil unrest. Preparation for the journey will include history and culture discussions with scholars, and motivational exercise sessions with elite Black athletes – all to prepare them for their first-ever trip to the continent of Africa.

The entire process will be documented, social media broadcasted, and ultimately edited into a weekly web-series and full-length documentary.

The project will establish an African-American leadership presence in Senegal and build a desperately needed new way forward in our people's development.
